



ADMISSION TO THE FCT-INTERNATIONAL DOCTORAL PROGRAM IN CULTURE STUDIES (INTDCS) 2018

On Thursday, July 5, 2018 the steering committee of INTDCS gathered (1) to assess the ranking of candidates, thereby fulfilling the admission criteria to the PhD program in accordance with 5.2. of the INTDCS by-laws, and (2) to select and rank them in accordance with 5.3 of the said by-laws.

Selection and ranking criteria were as follows:

1. Academic excellence (0-40 points): Very good or outstanding academic performance in previous degrees as demonstrated by transcript of records and quality of undergraduate higher education institution according to agreed recognition criteria;
2. Academic potential (0-20 points): Demonstrated by the research statement, interview and CV;
3. Motivation and innovation potential and professional skills (0-25 points): Demonstrated by the personal statement and research résumé;
4. English language skills (0-15 points): Required levels – IELTS 7.0 or TOEFL 100 + minimum 24 on all skills or Cambridge advanced Certificate B or Cambridge Proficiency or CEFR B2/C1.
